- Requires a diagnostic appointment, approximately \$90 (covered by Medicaid). Estimated cost of work will be given at this time. Please call 828-1287 or 828-1286 to set up an appointment.
- Payment due at first cleaning appointment.
- Payment may be DSHS ProviderOne Services Card, check, cash, or credit card (Visa & Master Card only).
- Clinic is open during EWU school year to include a short summer session.
